## CALCULATION OF GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) AND CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE (CPA):

A student's GPA for each semester is determined by the following procedure:

- The number of quality points (based on the grade earned in each course) in any one semester, is multiplied by the number of credits that the course carries.
- The product of such multiplication, for all courses taken in a semester, are added to get the total number of quality points.
- The total number of quality points is then divided by the total number of credits the student has attempted in the semester to obtain the GPA.

The calculation of the CPA follows the same procedure for all semesters except that it is based on all the courses for which the student has registered since the day s/he has enrolled in the University.

ACRS: Attempted credits – credits for which the student registers.

ECRS: Earned credits – completed credits.

QCRS: Quality credits – ECRS excluding TR, P, I, DE, Z and AU.

QPTS: Quality points

AECTS: Attempted ECTS – ECTS credits for which the student registers.

EECTS: Earned ECTS – ECTS completed credits.

## GRADING SYSTEM

Academic progress is evaluated on the following 4.0 grading system:

The following are not used in computing a student's grade point average, but the credits are included in the earned credits:

- P Pass Credit awarded for a pass/fail course, or in student internships/practica.
- TR Transfer Credit Courses transferred from other colleges and universities.

The following are not used in computing a student's grade point average, and the credits are not included in the earned credits:

- AU Audit No credit.
- I Incomplete Course not completed.
- DE Deferred Grade delayed.
- Z Course currently taken.

## REPEAT ENROLLMENT

Repeat courses are recorded on the student's transcript with the suffix R. When a course is repeated only the highest grade is recorded on the transcript.

## INDEPENDENT STUDY

Independent study courses are recorded on the student's transcript with the suffix I.

## TRANSFER CREDIT

Credit awarded to work satisfactorily completed at another institution is recorded on the student's transcript as transfer credit. The transfer credits are included in the credits earned but not in computing the grade point average.

## AUTHENTICATION OF THE RECORD

A transcript is official when it is printed on transcript paper, and bears the signature of the Registrar and the embossed seal of the University.
